Clothing

- Fleece or wool sweater
- Hiking pants and hiking shorts
- T-shirts
- Hiking socks
- Liner socks
- Swim suit
- Sun hat

Outerwear

- Rain jacket or waterproof poncho (Breathable, waterproof)
- Rain pants (Lightweight, breathable, waterproof)

Footwear

- Sturdy hiking boots, broken-in with aggressive tread
- Water Sandals
- Camp shoes-tennis shoes, sandals or flip flops

Toiletries and Accessories

- Biodegradable soap/shampoo
- Toothbrush
- Toothpaste
- Sunscreen and lip balm
- Aloe Vera or Lotion
- Hand wipes
- Toilet paper
- Insect repellent
- 100oz of water
- Towel
- Small personal first aid
- Ziploc bags
- Flashlight or headlamp

Luggage

- Lightweight duffel bag to carry your personal gear (up to 15 lbs) YOU carry anything over 15lbs. This duffel will go into a container on the and you will get it when the horses arrive at the campground.
- Daypack (2000-2500 cu. in) that can carry at least 100oz of water, lunch and your accessories: camera, sunscreen, extra socks, rain gear etc.

- Spare contact lenses or glasses
- Games, toys, Frisbee, cards etc.
